Family Emergency Preparedness & Evacuation Actions

Create a Disaster Plan:

Discuss the types of disasters most likely to happen.

Understand our Borough Warning Signals:

- Steady Wail-Emergency Management
- Pulsed Steady-First Aid Squad Alert
- Alternating Wail-Fire Dept Alert
- Public Access

Pick two places to meet:

1. Right outside your home in case of a sudden emergency, like a fire
 2. Outside your neighborhood in case you can't return home (everyone must know the address and phone#).
- Establish an out-of-state friend to act as a contact for separated family members.
 - Show each member of the household how to turn off water, gas and electricity and consider neighbors who may need assistance.
 - Monitor weather conditions on NOAA Weather Radio 162.550 Mhz.
 - Post emergency numbers by all telephones.
 - Install smoke detectors on each level of your home.
 - Register family emergency cell phone number for Two River Alert at www.tworivalert.com

Prepare a Family Disaster Supplies Kit Before a disaster strikes:

- Prescription medication & medical information.
- Special dietary food if required.
- First Aid Kits for home & car.
- Lantern, or flashlights.
- Food that does not need to be refrigerated or cooked. (Rotate at least every 6 months).
- Personal aids, eyeglasses, hearing aids.
- Insurance Information.
- Portable radio and extra batteries.
- Baby supplies, food, formula, diapers.
- Water in plastic containers. (Change frequently).

Protect Important Papers & Valuables: Keep items in an air-tight plastic bag.

- Social Security Cards
- Driver's License
- Insurance Policies
- Savings & Checking account books
- Birth Certificates
- Cash & Credit Cards
- Deeds
- Inventory of household goods
- Marriage/death records
- Stocks and bonds
