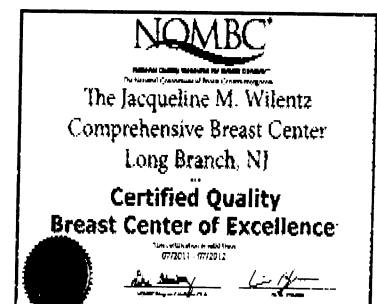
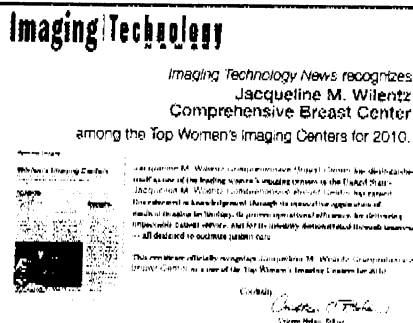
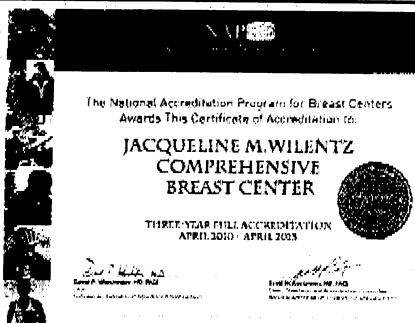
## Free Screening Mammograms
