

## Neighborly Considerations

- Secure all building materials & supplies to avoid wind blowing items to adjacent properties
- Moisten dust and sand to limit wind distribution beyond work site
- Check overhead utility lines to insure height is above all delivery vehicles
- Properly dispose of all food items and containers so as not to encourage scavenging by wild life.
- Park all vehicles so as not to obscure stop signs and school crossing signs
- Routinely pick up all nails and other items that could puncture tires
- Keep radio and boom boxes sound to a reasonable level
- Limit usage of neighbor's driveways for turning-around of service vehicles only with owner's permission
- Avoid using parking spots normally used by adjacent property owners
- Keep sidewalks clear for pedestrian usage
- Have ready access to police, fire, and first aid telephone numbers
- Do not leave ladders on buildings that might be an invitation for children to explore
- Secure all materials at the end of day to discourage any "mid-night requisitoners"; for general safety; and to ensure environmental protection
