SIGN REGULATIONS

1) No posting sale signs on telephone poles, trees or stakes. Signs may be posted on private property where the sale is to be held or on property owner (listed below) who has granted permission for posting a sign:

Placement other than above locations are expressively prohibited.

2) Signs NOT to exceed 2' x 3'. Signs are not permitted to be erected earlier than 2 days prior to sale or auction and must be removed immediately upon expiration of the permit.

3.) Summonses will be issued by the police or code enforcement without further warning, if the provisions regulating such sales are violated.

BOROUGH ORDINANCE

In accordance with Shrewsbury Ordinance, Chapter 60-B "Private Sales and Auctions" Section 60-B-3:

Upon receipt of an application the Borough Clerk shall refer same to the Police Department, which shall examine the proposed sale site to determine whether the proposed sale poses a possible threat to pedestrian vehicular or public safety. In the event the police department determines that special conditions should be imposed on the sale for reasons of pedestrian, vehicular public safety, the Police Department shall make such reasonable conditions as may be necessary to protect the public.

These conditions may include (but are not limited to):

- Requiring the permittee to employ a special police officer, or officers, to direct traffic and/or pedestrians.
- Limiting the hours of the sale: _____

- Limiting the number of persons at the sale site not to exceed: _____
