

PUBLIC NOTICE TO ALL VOTERS IN THE BOROUGH OF LITTLE SILVER AND BOROUGH OF SHREWSBURY IN MONMOUTH COUNTY

This notice is published pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:12-7. A Special School Election will be held October 6, 2022, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to vote on proposals.

THE DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR THE SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION WAS THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2022.

VOTING REQUIREMENTS

To vote in Monmouth County, you must be a United States citizen, you will be 18 years of age by the next election, you will be a resident of the State and County 30 days before the election, and you are NOT currently serving a sentence of incarceration due to a conviction for an indictable offense under any federal or State laws. Registration deadline is 21 days before an election.

ATTENTION VOTERS WHO HAVE MOVED

If you are a registered voter in Monmouth County and have moved within the County, you should submit a change of address with the Commissioner of Registration, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, NJ, 07728 phone #732-431-7780.

If you are a registered voter who has moved within the County, and you did not notify the County Commissioner of Registration of your new address, you will be permitted to vote at this election as follows: (1) Go to the polling place for the election district in which you reside on election day. (2) Tell the District Election Board Member that you are registered to vote but have moved within the County. (3) You will be permitted to vote by provisional ballot. You will need to provide your name, current and old addresses, date of birth and signature on the envelope provided with the ballot. You may call the Commissioner of Registration or your Municipal Clerk to determine your proper polling place location.

NOTE: HAVA (Help America Vote Act) REQUIREMENTS

First-time "Mail-in" registrants, voting in a Federal Election, **MUST** provide **I.D.** before voting.

Under New Jersey law you have the right to vote in privacy, to have a reasonable amount of time to vote, to receive a replacement ballot if you spoil the first one, and to bring written material into the polling place for your personal use.

A "Voter's Bill of Rights" will be prominently displayed at your polling place. If you believe that your right to vote has been violated in any way, you should immediately notify your county Board of Elections or county Superintendent of Elections.

"Pursuant to provisions of the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act of 1984" (Public law 98-435), a telecommunication device for the deaf (TDD) is maintained at the Election Division, Department of State, Trenton, New Jersey.

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AT THIS SPECIAL SCHOOL ELECTION, THE FOLLOWING PROPOSALS WILL BE VOTED UPON:

LITTLE SILVER

Proposal

The Board of Education of the Borough of Little Silver in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to Markham Place School and to Point Road Elementary School, including the acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment, and any site work; and (b) to appropriate \$35,930,174, and to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$35,930,174.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$35,080,729 (consisting of \$18,443,115 for Markham Place School and \$16,637,614 for Point Road Elementary School). The project includes \$849,445 (consisting of \$22,005 for Markham Place School and \$827,440 for Point Road Elementary School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this special election.

SHREWSBURY BOROUGH

Proposal

Shall The Board of Education of the Borough of Shrewsbury, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey ("School District"), be authorized to: (a) undertake for lawful school purposes, a capital improvement program at the **Shrewsbury Borough School** consisting of (i) construction of an addition consisting of pre-kindergarten classrooms, a student resource room with options for small group instruction, and a cafeteria with storage space and adjacent restrooms fully compliant with the American Disabilities Act, (ii) replacement and/or upgrading to the electrical, communications, fire, safety, utility and HVAC systems, along with related roof repairs, and the replacement, improvement and/or repair of the windows, doors, walls and ceilings, together with the completion of exterior work and other site improvements at the facility, and (iii) the completion of such other work and improvements, and acquisition of furniture, fixtures and equipment as may be necessary therefor or related to the projects set forth above; (b) expend for all the foregoing an amount not to exceed \$22,517,820 (\$11,907,012 of which represents eligible costs ("Final Eligible Costs"), as determined by the Commissioner of Education); (c) issue bonds of the School District for said project in an amount not to exceed \$22,517,820, in which event the State will pay 40.00% of the debt service (principal and interest) of the school bonds issued to finance the Final Eligible Costs; and (d) transfer unexpended bond proceeds between said school facility projects. This school facilities project includes \$10,610,808 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facility efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g)*.
