RESOLUTION APPOINTING TAX ASSESSOR**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has the need to appoint a Tax Assessor due to the retirement of the former Assessor, whose term ends on June 30, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40A:9-148 provides, "Every municipal tax assessor and deputy assessor shall hold his office for a term of 4 years from the first day of July next following his appointment. Vacancies other than due to expiration of term shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term;" and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough wishes to appoint Matthew Barbieri as Tax Assessor to fill the remainder of the four-year term ending June 30, 2027.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the Borough of Shrewsbury, that Matthew Barbieri is appointed Tax Assessor effective immediately to complete the unexpired term ending June 30, 2027.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Office of the Municipal Clerk shall forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Chief Financial Officer.
